EXAMEN PHYSIQUE AVANT PARTICIPATION AUX ACTIVITÉS SPORTIVES

Avis aux parents ou tuteurs légaux :

Les élèves inscrits dans les grades 9-12 doivent passer un examen physique annuel afin de pouvoir participer dans les programmes d'athlétisme interscolaires et de conditionnement scolaire de Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS). Les élèves inscrits dans les grades 7-8 doivent passer un examen médical tous les deux ans afin de participer dans le programme d'athlétisme interscolaire aux collèges de MCPS.

L'examen médical est réalisé par un prestataire de santé agréé.

L'examen physique avant participation se compose de quatre parties : formulaire d'antécédents (pages 1 et 2), formulaire d'examen physique (page 3), formulaire pour athlètes en situation de handicap : Complément au formulaire d'antécédents de l'athlète (page 4) et formulaire d'éligibilité médicale (page 5).

L'élève doit remettre la dernière page uniquement (FORMULAIRE D'ÉLIGIBILITÉ MÉDICALE - page 5) à l'école ou à l'entraîneur avant sa participation. Le prestataire de santé agréé conserve les quatre premières pages.

Lorsqu'un élève athlète subit une blessure, maladie ou opération importante après avoir transmis son formulaire annuel d'examen physique avant participation, une lettre d'approbation issu d'un prestataire de santé agréé lui sera nécessaire pour poursuivre sa participation aux activités physiques.

Les informations relatives à la santé soumises à l'école seront disponibles uniquement au personnel de santé et d'éducation qui ont un intérêt légitime dans l'éducation de votre enfant.

Les dispenses pour un examen physique sont permises si elles sont contraires aux croyances religieuses d'un élève. Dans de telles circonstances, la famille doit soumettre une vérification.

Si l'élève nécessite une prise de médicament ou tout traitement destiné à être administré à l'école ou lors d'entraînement ou d'évènements sportifs, votre prestataire de santé agréé doit remplir un formulaire d'administration de médicament ou traitement, et ce pour chaque médicament ou traitement concerné. Ces formulaires peuvent être obtenus à l'école de votre enfant ou en ligne sur le site Internet de Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) à www.montgomeryschoolsmd.org Formulaire MCPS 525-12, *Autorisation d'administration d'un traitement médical prescrit, accord de transmission et dédommagement*, formulaire MCPS 525-13, *Autorisation d'administration d'un médicament prescrit, accord de transmission et dédommagement*, formulaire MCPS 525-14, *Soin d'urgence pour la gestion d'un élève suite à diagnostic de choc anaphylactique, accord de transmission et dédommagement pour auto-injecteur d'épinéphrine*. Si vous n'avez pas accès à un prestataire de soins de santé agréé ou si votre enfant a besoin d'une procédure spéciale individuelle de santé, veuillez contacter le directeur/la directrice et/ou l'infirmier(ère) de l'école de votre enfant.
