QUESTION:

Why was the summer pre-AP prep program at Martin Luther King Middle School discontinued?
Was it replaced with another program?

ANSWER:

The summer Pre-AP Academy was a grant-funded program that was established to prepare middle school students who were not previously identified for GT and honors classes for future AP work. The program served rising Grade 8 and rising Grade 9 students. Students were enrolled in an English, science, or social studies class that was co-taught by two teachers (one each from Martin Luther King, Jr. Middle School and Seneca Valley High School). When grant funding ended, the program was discontinued. The program was not replaced by another program.
