

Wootton Exchange Trip to China

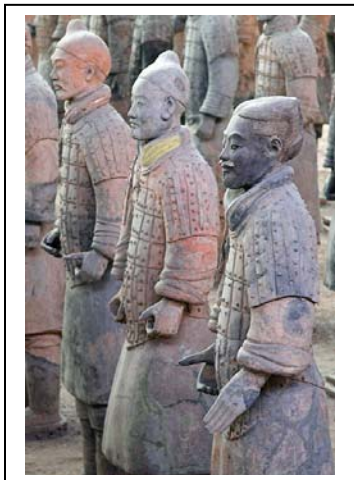
Spring Break 2009

Trip Highlights

- Fly from Dulles to Beijing

 - Markets, theatre, shopping, food!
- Visit and learn about Chinese high school:
 - Math and English classes

- Go to see the Terracotta Warriors in Xi'an
 - Take overnight train
 - Visit the Warrior site and see a traditional dance show
 - Fly back to Beijing and then home
