Report of the Actuarial Valuation of the Investment Trust

Mr. Rowe and Ms. Trevino gave a presentation on the actuarial valuation of the Investment Trust. Total contributions for 1999 were stable and saw a decline in the 2001–2002 investments, but should start to recover. Several areas were discussed by the committee members, including the change in interest rate assumption of eight percent and the impact of market fluctuation. The actuarial consultants shared that some of the outcomes were due to changes to pension benefits, improved employee benefits, length of service, and improved recorded keeping,

Inspector General's Follow-up Report on Transportation

MCPS staff reviewed the Inspector Generals' follow-up report on the Montgomery County Public Schools Bus Transportation Program. The original report was done in 2000. The follow-up report focused on the 19 findings from the original performance audit, in which MCPS agreed to implement various corrective actions. Only two findings had financial implications—phone line reimbursement and maintenance of buses.
