

RESOLUTION NO. 200-88 Re: RELOCATION OF STATE-OWNED CLASSROOM BUILDINGS

On recommendation of the superintendent and on motion of Dr. Cronin seconded by Mrs. Praisner, the following resolution was adopted unanimously:

WHEREAS, The following sealed bids were received on April 12, 1988, for the relocation of state-owned classroom buildings:

RESOLVED, That a contract for \$267,307.69 be awarded to J & L Services for Proposal A and that a contract for \$48,000.00 be awarded to H & H Enterprises for Proposal B, contingent upon County Council approval of the Board's Capital Budget request for a FY 1988 supplemental appropriation to relocate modular classrooms; and be it further

RESOLVED, That a copy of the contracts be forwarded to the State Interagency Committee for Public School Construction.

RESOLUTION NO. 201-88 Re: RELOCATION OF LEASED CLASSROOMS

On recommendation of the superintendent and on motion of Dr. Cronin seconded by Mrs. Praisner, the following resolution was adopted unanimously:

WHEREAS, The following sealed bids were received on April 12, 1988, for the relocation of leased classroom buildings:

and

WHEREAS, The low bid is within staff estimate; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That a contract for \$129,900 be awarded to J & L Services to relocate leased classroom buildings, contingent upon County Council approval of the Board's Capital Budget request for a FY 1988

supplemental appropriation to relocate modular classrooms.
