QUESTION:

Provide a performance evaluation of the schools in the Wootton cluster using available statistical data.

ANSWER:

The disaggregated data provided in the attached tables are used to inform and guide discussions about school performance. The tables illustrate the relative performance of students who attend the same school but differ in gender; race/ethnicity; or participation in Free and Reduced-price Meals System (FARMS), special education, or limited English proficiency (LEP) services. Additionally, the tables allow stakeholders to examine the relative performance of students who attend different schools but share the same demographic characteristics.
