**Opti-Vision Program**

National Vision Administrators, LLC (NVA) offers a discount vision program which enables plan participants to get eye examinations and purchase frames, lenses, contact lenses and other services at discount prices when these services are obtained from an NVA participating provider.

**Where To Get Services** – NVA has a network of participating Ophthalmologists, Optometrists and Opticians to serve you. A list of participating providers can be obtained from our customer service department or our website which is [www.e-nva.com](http://www.e-nva.com).

**How The Program Works** – As a covered member, you will receive an identification card listing your covered participants. Please review your identification card carefully for accuracy. If the card contains any errors, please contact your Benefits Office immediately. You or your covered dependent, simply present your NVA identification card to a participating provider. This will entitle you to the discount pricing available under this program. The discount card cannot be used in conjunction with any other offer (including, but not limited to coupons, special promotions, etc.). There is no limit to the number of times you may use your identification card to obtain discount eyewear and services. However, the MCPS schedule of benefits does limit the frequency of services for which insurance reimbursements are made. After receiving services, you then pay the discount price for the services received, and complete and send the claim form to NVA.

**Lens Options** – The NVA participating provider will charge you up to their wholesale cost, plus fifty percent (50%) for each option selected, or their usual, customary and reasonable fee, whichever is less. Available lens options include Photochromatic, Scratch Resistant, Fashion or Gradient Tints, Progressive or No-line Multifocals, Anti-reflective, Polycarbonate and Prescription Sunglasses.

**Frames** – The participating provider will charge you up to the wholesale cost for frames, plus fifty percent (50%), or their usual, customary and reasonable fee, whichever is less.

**Contact Lenses** – The participating provider will charge you their usual, customary and reasonable fee, less twenty-five (25%) for standard or disposable contact lenses, including the contact lens examination.

**Exclusions** – The following services and materials are not covered under this program:

Medical or surgical treatments of the eyes; drugs or medications, non-prescription lenses, examinations or materials not listed as a covered service; services or materials provided by Federal, State, Local Government or Workers' Compensation, low vision aids.
