



Course and Tuition Guidelines

The elementary summer school program provides the opportunity for your child to enroll in **TWO** courses for the summer session. **Parents MUST select two courses from the list below and indicate those selections on the registration form, with the exception of those students enrolling in the ESOL program.** Students enrolling in the ESOL program may only register for one course.

Tuition for Two Courses:

Montgomery County Residents—\$335.00
Nonresidents—\$375.00

ESOL Tuition—\$140.00

Project Discovery (Forest Knolls ES)—
MCPS \$185.00 and MCRD \$240.00

Resident tuition is available for any student residing year-round in Montgomery County, or whose parent or legal guardian is a county resident.

Students may qualify for reduced tuition. To apply, complete and attach MCPS Form 325-4: *Application for Partial or Full Waiver of Summer School Tuition* and supporting documents. This form is available on the summer school Web site or in the main office at your local elementary school.

Eligible Students

The elementary summer school program is for students who have completed Grades K through 5 only. Students entering kindergarten this coming fall are not eligible for the program.

International students attending non-U.S. schools and not registered with the MCPS International Student Admissions Office are not eligible for the program.

Students enrolled are expected to comply with all rules and regulations of MCPS and their summer school center.

Special Needs

It is your responsibility to notify the summer school center of any important medical information that may pertain to your child.

Please provide the summer school site administrator with a copy of the accommodations included on the student's Individualized Education Plan (IEP) or 504 Plan if applicable.

Guidelines for Registration

Registration Begins: May 1, 2009
Absolute Deadline: June 24, 2009

Registration forms are available on the summer school Web site or at your local school. To register for the elementary summer program, **mail the fully completed registration form** and appropriate payment (check, money order, credit/debit card—VISA or MasterCard only) to the Regional Elementary Summer School Office, CESC, 850 Hungerford Drive, Room 170, Rockville, MD 20850-1718.

Walk-in registration is available only on the dates and at the locations and times listed below. Cash, along with other forms of payment, will be accepted at those times.

Refunds

Refunds will be made only if a student's class is canceled because of insufficient enrollment, or to students who have never attended a class. One day's attendance may make the student ineligible for a full refund. A request for a refund must be submitted in writing to the Regional Summer School Refund Office (CESC, 850 Hungerford Drive, Room 170, Rockville, MD 20850-1718) on or before August 1, 2008. The written request must include the student's name, MCPS ID number, the summer school course(s), location, and reason for withdrawal. Refunds will be processed as they are received.
