The Newport Mill Middle School (NMMS) Green Team is busy saving energy and increasing recycling rates. With double digit improvements this year, science teacher, Jessica Riegle, and her 28 students are campaigning to increase awareness at their school.

In addition to successfully increasing recycling rates by 30+% and reducing energy consumption by 13%, the team continues to improve the local communities' environment by:

- overseeing an educational campaign to save energy and increase recycling,
- conducting a SERT building energy audit for the entire school building,
- completing a school building temperature survey,
- volunteering for litter pickup along *Newport Mill Road*, and
- participating in the *Bay Grasses in the Classes* program.
