## Recycling Expectations

It's as easy as 1, 2, 3...



Follow these guidelines:

### Place in commingled recycling bins....

- *empty* plastic, glass, and aluminum containers
- remember to take off the tops of bottles & containers before putting in bins
- *empty* #10 kitchen cans

### Place in paper recycling bins...

- *empty* juice boxes
- *non-contaminated* paper including: copier paper, colored paper, magazines, composition books, bulletin board decorations, theme paper, newspapers
- broken down boxes
- paperback & hardback books

### Plastic bags:

- no plastic bags in dumpsters—empty all bags and throw bags in trash

**Exception: Only shredded paper in clear plastic bags is allowed in recycling dumpsters**

### Place in trash - not recycling...

food	contaminated paper	contaminated food containers
Styrofoam™	plastic bags	plastic spoons, forks, knives
furniture	wood	laminated paper
ceramics	construction material
