NComputing

- ❖ Four users share one computer at a single classroom station
- ❖ Good for basic computing tasks and Internet applications
- ❖ All four workstations must be located in close proximity
- ❖ Additional furniture may be required (not included)



Netbooks

- ❖ 10 Netbooks
- ❖ Wireless network connectivity to enhance mobility
- ❖ Good for basic computing tasks and Internet applications
- ❖ High resolution, small screen not ideal for students with vision impairments
- ❖ Without building-wide wireless Netbooks must be used within range of the cart and no more than five carts per school
- ❖ No CD drive
- ❖ Batteries - recharge every three hours; replace in two years
- ❖ 1 Year Warranty
