

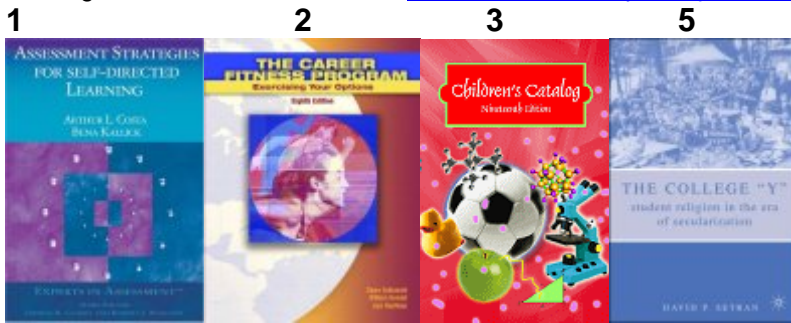
## 10 08 07 New Books in the Professional Library
