Classification of Certificates

I. PURPOSE

To publish the procedures governing the classification of certificates

II. PROCEDURES

- A. Certificates for newly employed personnel are classified first-class since scholarship, executive ability, personality, employment references, and other evidence of teaching efficiency are assessed as a part of the selection process. (See Regulations GEA-RA: *Selection and Appointment of Administrators, Supervisors, and Interns* and GEB-RA: *Recruitment, Employment, and Assignment of Certified Personnel*.)
- B. When certification renewal requirements are not met, a certificate will be rated second-class. Certificated personnel must meet all specific requirements to remove the second class designation within appropriate timelines.
- C. Employees whose certificates are rated second class will be notified in writing by the Office of Human Resources.
- D. A record of the kind, grade, and class of all certificates will be maintained by the Office of Human Resources.
