MEMORANDUM

Subject: Key Areas of Progress in Secondary Schools

Continued progress was made during the 2000-2001 school year in the completion of Algebra 1 or a higher-level mathematics course in middle school as well as in enrollment in at least one honors or Advanced Placement (AP) course in high school. Increases in the percentage of students successfully completing Algebra 1 or higher-level mathematics course were recorded in all three grades in middle school. The percentage of high school students enrolled in at least one honors or AP course increased by more than 5 percentage points.

- During the 2000-2001 school year, 36 students in Grade 6 completed Algebra 1 or a higher-level math course (Attachment 1). While the students represent less than half of 1 percent (0.3) of students in Grade 6, the number is a substantial increase over the numbers in 1999-2000 (10), 1998-99 (1), and 1997-98 (7) who completed Algebra 1 or a higher-level math course.
- The percentage of Grade 7 students successfully completing Algebra 1 or a higher-level mathematics course has steadily increased over the past four years, from 2.6 percent in 1997-1998 to 8.0 percent in 2000-2001 (Attachment 2). Last year, the percentage of African American (1.9 percent) and Hispanic (1.8 percent) students who completed Algebra 1 or a higher-level mathematics course doubled compared to the prior year, and the percent of Asian American and White students saw a 50 percent increase, to 14.3 and 10.7 percent respectively.
- In the 2000-2001 year, Montgomery County Public Schools had the highest percentage (45.2) of students successfully completing Algebra 1 or a higher-level mathematics course by the end of Grade 8 since the Grade 8 benchmark (32.8 percent) was established in 1995-1996 (Attachment 3). The increase was 4.3 percentage points over the total for the prior year. The highest percentage also was achieved among African American students (23.9 percent), up more than 7 percentage points; Asian American students (62.8 percent), up nearly 2 percentage points; Hispanic students (19.0), up nearly 5 percentage points; and White students (57.0 percent), up more than 5 percentage points.

- The highest percentage of high school students enrolled in at least one honors or AP course (61.1 percent) since the benchmark was established in 1990 was achieved last year, an increase of over 5 percentage points from the previous year (Attachment 4). All high schools except one showed an increase. In addition, each racial/ethnic group recorded an increase in the percentage of students enrolled in at least one honors or AP course and had its highest percentage ever enrolled in these challenging courses. Compared to the prior year, the percentage of African American students enrolled in at least one honors or AP course increased by over 7 percentage points; the Asian American students increased by 5 percentage points; the Hispanic students increased by over 4 percentage points; and the White students increased by over 5 percentage points.

Further, the percentage of students successfully completing Algebra 1 or a higher-level mathematics course by the end of Grade 9 increased 2.2 percent over results reported for the 1998-1999 school year (Attachment 5). The Grade 9 results previously reported for the 1999-2000 school year have been found to be noncomparable to current and prior years' results due to a problem in the transfer of data between the Student Information System used in 1999-2000 and the Student Legacy System. The problem affected only the Grade 9 data. A comparison of the 1998-1999 and 2000-2001 results for each racial/ethnic group shows that each group made gains over the two-year period, with African American students posting a 4.9 percent increase, Asian American students a 3.3 percent increase, Hispanic students a 2.7 percent increase, and White students a 1.5 percent increase.

I will continue to keep you informed about our progress in these key areas.
