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2003–2004 Enrollment in at Least One Honors or Advanced Placement Course

Continued progress was made during the 2003–2004 school year in increasing the enrollment of students in at least one honors or Advanced Placement (AP) course in high school. The Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) seeks to increase enrollment in and performance of all students in gifted, honors, Advanced Placement (AP), and other advanced programs as part of ongoing efforts to provide an effective instructional program—one of four major goals identified in *Our Call to Action: Pursuit of Excellence*. This report measures the progress all high schools have made toward increasing the enrollment of students in at least one honors or AP course.

MCPS has undertaken efforts designed to prepare and encourage more students to stretch themselves academically and to take the most challenging courses. Various systemwide and individual school initiatives have opened the enrollment and encouraged more diverse student participation in honors and AP courses. Initiatives include creating a positive school climate that communicates high expectations for all students, motivating students to participate in challenging coursework, and removing barriers to the recruitment and selection of students for enrollment in honors and AP courses.

This report differs from prior honors or AP enrollment reports in two important ways. First, it includes students who received more than 15 hours of special education services. *Our Call to Action* is committed to providing information about all students and disaggregating results by race/ethnicity, gender, disability status, Limited English Proficiency (LEP), and economic disadvantage (Free and Reduced-price Meals). This report includes all special education students in data from prior years.

Secondly, MCPS had established a new baseline year of 1999–2000 to measure progress over time. However, 1999–2000 enrollments in at least one honors or AP course are no longer available. Therefore, 2000–2001 has been established as the baseline year for assessing progress made in honors/AP course enrollment.

Findings

Compared to the prior year, 2003–2004 enrollment in at least one honors or AP course increased for all students and for all groups of students. (See Table 1.) The percent of economically disadvantaged, White, and Hispanic students enrolled in at least one honors or AP course increased by 2.0, 2.1, and 2.2 percentage points respectively. The percent of Asian American and LEP students enrolled in at least one honors or AP course increased by 1.0 and 1.6 percentage points respectively. The percent of both African American and special education students enrolled in at least one honors or AP course increased by less than 1 percent.

During 2003–2004, all students showed an increase of nearly 8 percentage points in enrollment in at least one honors or AP course compared to the baseline year of 2000–2001. (See Table 2.) Additionally, the percent of all groups of students enrolled in at least one honors or AP course showed an increase. Economically disadvantaged students showed the greatest increase, rising from 25.6 percent to 36.4 percent. The enrollment of African American, White, and Hispanic students rose by approximately 9 percentage points; the enrollment of LEP and Asian American students rose by nearly 8 percentage points; and the enrollment of special education students rose by more than 4.5 percentage points over the four-year period.

Additionally, 26 out of 27 high schools showed an increase in the enrollment of all students in at least one honors or AP course between the baseline years of 2000–2001 and 2003–2004. (See Table 3.) Eleven schools increased the enrollment of all students between 0.1 and 5.0 percentage points; 7 schools increased enrollment between 5.1 and 10.0 percentage points; 5 schools increased enrollment between 10.1 and 15.0 percentage points; and 2 schools increased enrollment between 15.1 and 20.0 percentage points.
