***SGA President of the Year Award***

The student government association (SGA) president works hard during the school year to support the school community. They contribute to many successes of the school. Although this award goes to an individual SGA president, it really highlights the work of the school's entire SGA and compliments the work of all SGA presidents throughout the county.

**Nomination Process:**

1. Each school is eligible to nominate one SGA president. Nominees must be from MCJC member schools.
2. Schools need to submit their nominations to the Student Affairs Office by April 13, 2012.
3. A selection committee comprised of MCJC officers and advisor, awards director, and a few other MCJC staff will review application. Any of the above that are from an applicant's school will be removed from the selection committee.
4. The award recipient will be announced at the awards General Assembly.

**Criteria:**

1. SGA president must be from a MCJC member school
2. The SGA president submitted his/her contact information to MCJC so he/she received information directly from MCJC (contact reporting link is on the home page of the MCJC web site – [www.mcjc.info](http://www.mcjc.info))
3. SGA president must have attended at least two MCJC general assemblies in the year for which he/she is being nominated.
4. It is strongly encouraged that the SGA president has attended at least one MCJC executive board meeting in the year for which he/she is being nominated.
5. SGA president or designee has contributed information for the MCJC newsletter (published at the end of each semester, so the school would have needed to submit a report by the January deadline for the 1<sup>st</sup> semester newsletter).
6. The SGA president conducts regular meetings at his/her school (attach agendas for all meetings to date).
7. The SGA president has set organizational/personal goals (attach documentation).
8. One letter of recommendation is required from the SGA advisor or principal (or other administrator who works closely with the SGA).
