

ELECTION JUDGES NEEDED!



The Montgomery County Board of Elections seeks MCPS faculty and students with Spanish speaking fluency to participate as Election Judges during the 2012 Presidential Elections.

Primary: Tuesday, April 3, 2012
General: Tuesday, November 6, 2012



Need:

- As per Section 203 of the 1975 Voting Rights Act, the Montgomery County Board of Elections is required to identify and employ election judges with Spanish speaking skills.

Requirements:

- U.S. Citizenship;
- Must be registered to vote in Maryland;
 - A registered 17 year old may vote and participate as an election judge in the 2012 Election (*17-year-olds must have permission from a parent/guardian to serve*)
- Complete and mail the "Election Judge Questionnaire" and "Voter Registration Application"; and
- Successfully complete training (*3 hours/scheduled for January 2012*)

Benefits:

- Election Judges will receive a \$30 stipend for training and \$150 for Election Day service (Student Service Learning credits (SSL) maybe substituted for stipend);
- Enhance your essay submission for future college applications;
- New-found insight and interest in civic participation; and
- Strengthen Democracy
