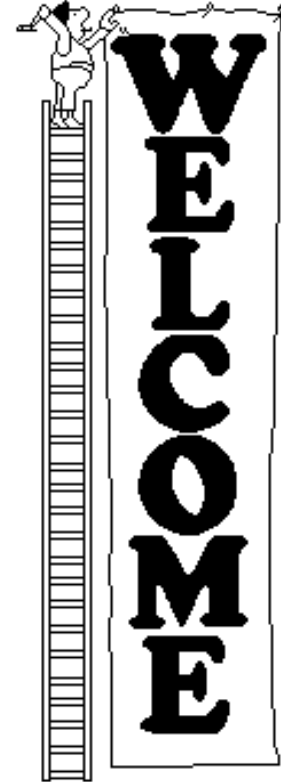


WELCOME TO THE SGA!
