

**Students have face-to-face contact with the service recipients. For Example: tutoring, serving meals at a homeless shelter, working with the elderly in a nursing home.**

**Students perform a service without having face-to-face contact with the recipient. Usually resources are channeled to help alleviate a problem. For Example: food and clothing drives, "a-thons" or fundraisers, environmental projects.**

**Students educate others about a particular issue with the goal being to eliminate the cause of a particular problem. For Example: writing letters to legislators or editors, preparing and displaying poster, plays, or other educational materials for others.**
