



# HOMework CLUB

Dear Parents and Students,

Baker Middle School is continuing the successful after school program called "Homework Club." ***The purpose of the group is to help students be more successful when completing their homework, by providing a structured and fun atmosphere that includes peer and adult support. The group meets on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays after school from 2:45-4:00*** and it is directed by Mrs. Dupré, Mrs. Friedman or Mrs. Norton. As a member, students ***don't*** need to attend all three days. They can choose to attend every meeting, or come on a "need to" basis.

On Tuesdays and Wednesdays the group meets in Mrs. Dupré's classroom (Rm. 201) directly after school and on Thursdays they meet in Mrs. Norton classroom (Rm. 225). The students refer to their planner and make a list of goals (assignments) they will try to complete during the assigned hour. The group then moves to the media center where the students immediately begin working on their goals for the day. They are encouraged to get peer and teacher support on any challenging assignments, and to use the computers when necessary. At the end of the session, they reflect back on their original goals, check off the assignments that were completed, and make note of the work that still needs to be done at home. The activity bus is available after school on these days.

***In order for your child to become a member of the group you both will need to review and agree upon the rules that listed below:***

1. Students need to arrive in Mrs. Dupré's or Mrs. Norton's room **before 2:50 pm**, after having packed up their locker. **Students who do not arrive by the designated time will be escorted to the office and will need to call home for a ride.**
2. Students should arrive to the group with **all necessary materials** (planner, books, etc. ).
3. Students are expected to copy their homework from each class in their planner during each class period. ***It is essential they have their homework written down in order to identify the homework they should be working on, and each assignment is due.***
4. The student's desire to be a member of the group will be reflected by their effort and cooperation. ***Students should not be forced to stay after school, because their success will depend largely on their individual effort. If there is no evidence of participation and effort on the student's part, their dismissal from the group will be considered.***
