HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT COURSES AGREEMENT FORM

Algebra 1, Honors Geometry, Advanced English 8, and Spanish 1 and 2 are high school credit bearing courses that are taught at the middle school. In order to earn the high school credit, students must pass both semesters and the semester B final exam. Students who meet the criteria by earning an A, B, C, or D will receive high school credit. The grade earned in the class will appear on the student's high school transcript and be included in the student's high school grade point average (GPA). Scheduling high school courses in middle school is an enriching and rigorous undertaking that requires serious commitment on the part of the student and parent.

****Students who fail semester A of Algebra 1 will be placed in Algebra Prep for semester 2.****

Please understand that making a schedule change after the student has begun the class may not be possible. It has serious effects both on the student's individual schedule and on the class size of the course into which he/she would be transferring. Therefore it is important to give careful consideration before signing up for these courses.
