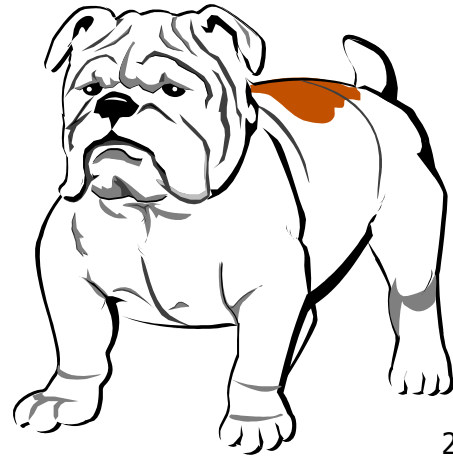


Baker Middle School Math Department



2009 Summer Math Packets

To prepare the Baker math students for the rigor of the school year, each student will be assigned a summer math packet. The packet contains problems that review skills needed for successful completion of each mathematics course curriculum. 2009/2010

- Students entering Math 6 will practice the skills of multiplication and division.
- Students entering Math 7 will practice fraction and decimal operations.
- Students entering Algebra Prep/IM will practice integer and fraction operations.
- Students entering Algebra will practice solving equations and calculator procedures.
- Students entering Geometry will practice factoring and multiplication of polynomials.
- Students exiting Geometry will review Algebra skills needed for Algebra 2 at the high school.

Each packet has an attached Parent Answer Key. The packets will be distributed to the students during the week of June 8 through June 12 and will be collected by their math teacher the first week of the 2009/2010 school year. Extra packets will be available in the Baker Middle School Counseling Office and on the school website. Completion of the packet will count towards the Quarter 1 homework grade and will be used as part of our evaluation to ensure that each student is placed in the most rigorous setting for mathematics success.
