PURPOSE: The purpose of the Unglesbee scholarship is to assist hard-working and self-motivated Blake High School graduating seniors in their pursuit of higher education. Mr. Unglesbee was a longtime Brookeville resident and local businessman & leader in the community who believed in community service. This year the Olney Lions Club will award a **\$1,000** scholarship in his name to a Blake HS graduate in good academic standing who has an outstanding community service record and some financial need. The scholarship will be presented by a Club representative at the Blake Awards Ceremony on **May 24, 2011 at 7:00 pm** to the most qualified senior meeting the eligibility criteria listed below:

REQUIREMENTS:

- (1) Graduating **senior** of Blake High School in good standing with **significant community service**.
- (2) Minimum cumulative **unweighted GPA of 2.5** (provide high school transcript)
- (3) Plans to attend an accredited 2 or 4 year college/university or vocational school this fall.
- (4) Provide **letter of recommendation** from a teacher or guidance counselor
- (5) Provide copy of **college acceptance letter**.
- (6) On a separate sheet of paper, describe your most meaningful community service experience, and your need for this scholarship. Limit the essay to no more than two pages typed & double spaced.
- (7) Attach **resume** that includes academic honors or awards, extra-curricular activities (including leadership roles), community service or employment.
- (8) Winner **must attend** a presentation event in the community. At the conclusion of their first semester in college, the recipient will write a letter to the Olney lions that describes his/her academic experience to date.
