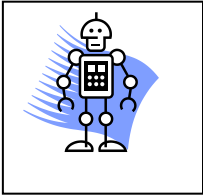


CJMS After-School Activities - Session 2

Hip Hop: This class focuses on learning the new dance moves from the High School Musical movies as well from other sources, and the latest improvisations on basic urban-themed dance. The benefits of movement and dance include body awareness, improved self-expression and confidence. This is also a fun way to build self-esteem and coordination. Hip Hop is an upbeat and energetic dance form which builds self confidence and adds the benefits of physical exercise. Cost: \$149

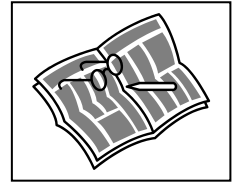


Robotics: After learning the basics of robot construction, students are given the opportunity to participate in a competitive robot-building activity within the context of real-world robotics. The class touches on subjects such as artificial intelligence, robots in art and literature, types of robots, different theories of robotics and perception and action systems. The class then divides into groups which construct a robot sensitive to touch and sound, experimenting with different wiring architectures to manifest different behaviors. Each group then places their robot in an obstacle course and using sound, steers it towards a finish line, and may the fastest team win! Cost: \$169

Journalism: Do you dream of being the next editor of The Washington Post, or becoming a high-profile writer for your favorite pop-culture magazine? Through group activities, participants learn to design their own magazine, newspaper or TV copy, and create journalistic pieces to add to their portfolios. Cost: \$144

Materials needed are an A440 tuning fork, flat, picks, guitar (preferably a folk guitar), and pencil and journal for notes. Minimum of 6 students. Cost: \$145



Fashion Design 101: Are you an avid reader of fashion magazines? Inspired by shows like *Project Runway*? If fashion is your passion, then Fashion Design 101 is the class for you! Appropriate for students with little or no design experience, this class will focus on the principles of design and color and participants will apply them to their very own styles. Students will design and print woven and knit textiles; will render technical sketches; and create their own clothing. Fashion design is a fun and creative way to merge imagination and artistic vision! Cost: \$148
