In The Classroom



In Math, the students will be counting money (quarters, dimes, nickels, and pennies). They will also be working on fractions (including fractions of a set), estimating numbers, and problem solving. Continue to practice basic math facts for addition and subtraction up to eighteen.

In Reading, the students will be learning how to read flyers and menus. The county reading tests will be administered once again. Please remember that your child should be reading for fifteen minutes every night.

In Science, the students will be learning about Rocks, Sand and Soil.

In Social Studies, the students will be discussing their past, present, and future. They will be creating a timeline of their life as well as writing their own autobiography.
