Criteria for Team Selection

Selection to the squad will be based on, but not limited to, the following criteria:

Attitude	Attendance	Commitment	Perseverance

Athletes will be assessed on each criterion through observation by the coaching staff.

Eligibility:

Athletes must turn in all paperwork (medical evaluation, parent permission, medical emergency card, and transportation forms) prior to the tryout start. Athletes must have, and maintain, a 2.0 GPA in order to remain eligible. Athletes must bring their second quarter report card to the tryout. Athletes must attend all classes, on time, and dress and participate in Physical Education classes on practice and game days.

Practice:

Practice attendance is mandatory. Practice will be held every day school is in session from 3:00 until 5:00 PM unless otherwise noted. There will be no practice on game days. If school is cancelled for any reason, games and practices scheduled for that day are cancelled as well. If you are going to be late for practice, or will miss practice, call Coach Tippett at 301-367-3124 or Coach Dickinson at 301-943-4505. Please schedule appointments during non practice times unless there is an emergency.

Games and Playing Time:

Game attendance is mandatory. Playing time is **earned**. Montgomery County hosts a competitive league for co-ed volleyball and we expect to have a competitive program. The coaches will decide who has earned playing time in any particular game. Playing time will not be equitable. The coaches will play the athletes who will help the team be most successful in a given situation.

Commitment:

The coaching staff is looking forward to a committed group of athletes who will make the team competitive. Athletes must be willing to put the team first and themselves second. Coyotes often run in packs, work together for a common cause such as hunting, and defer to a definitive leader. As coaches we expect the same commitment and mentality from our athletes.

Sportsmanship:

Montgomery County Public Schools emphasizes appropriate sportsmanship from all team members, coaches and parents. As coaches, we expect everyone in attendance at games will be respectful, encouraging, supportive, and appreciative of the effort and play of both teams and referees. We will also adhere to these concepts at practice.
