Dear Parents:

Preparations for the 2009 New York City trip are in full swing. We have reserved the buses, booked hotel rooms, and are scheduling activities for the students. This year's trip is certain to be an exciting and educational experience. The dates are set for the week of **October 19-23, 2009**.

Our students will be in school for five days, though not in the confines of the classroom walls. Their instructional program will be continued and expanded in a school without walls concept. Students will complete daily assignments and activities. Planned activities are aimed at giving students experiences in the arts and humanities, and the math, science and technology areas. We will also spend time working on a joint project with students from both programs. We have planned an educational experience for our students that build on and enrich their regular instructional program.

Students may cancel and receive a full refund prior to September 1, 2009. Because deposits are due to our hotel, bus carrier and other vendors, the first payment (\$200) will not be refundable after September 1, 2009. If the trip is cancelled at any time due to an unforeseen emergency situation after September 1, 2009, parents are responsible for the \$350 deposit and will be refunded the remainder of their payments.

Students participating in this trip must meet the following 2 major requirements:

- **2.0 grade point average and no failing grades for the 1st marking period**
- **Behavior that reflects the school's standards of character education**
