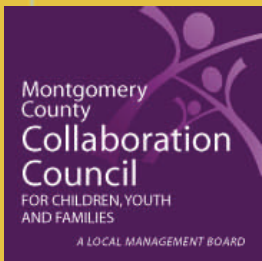

Welcome to the 2011-2012 school year! The Montgomery County Department of Recreation is partnering with the Roberto Clemente staff and Montgomery County Collaboration Council's Excel Beyond the Bell initiative to produce Roberto Clemente's **Success Beyond the Bell** After School Activities handbook.

The Recreation Department's Rec Extra program has a wide spectrum of programs in sports, recreation, fine arts, mentoring and life skills. Some examples of such programs are: babysitting courses, mosaic art clubs, scrap booking, flag football, lacrosse, blacktop basketball, tennis, volleyball, step dance teams, hip-hop dance and cartooning.

Success Beyond the Bell is Roberto Clemente's exciting new after school partnership with the Montgomery Department of Recreation's Rec Extra program and Montgomery County Collaboration Council's Excel Beyond the Bell community partners. During the 2011-2012 school year, we are pleased to offer students a variety of after school activities and clubs designed to allow participants to explore new areas of interest and cultivate and enhance skills in a safe, supportive environment.

Highlights for the 2011/2012 school year

- ◆ All activities are **free** and available to all students.
- ◆ After school activities are scheduled from **2:45 pm to 5:15 p.m., Monday through Thursday**, beginning October 3rd and ending May 24th.
- ◆ Bus transportation will be provided for students at 5:15 p.m. every day *Success Beyond the Bell* is in session for participating students.
- ◆ *Students may not ride on an after school activity bus if they did not participate in both after school activity periods.*
- ◆ ***After school supper is available at no cost to every student who participates in both after school activity periods.*** This is sponsored by MCPS Food and Nutrition Services through the USDA CACFP program.
- ◆ Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis prior to each new 10 week session throughout the year. Students must register for the programs listed in this booklet using the registration form inside. Please fill the form out completely and return it to Eileen Carraway, Room 232 at Clemente.

Additional Information

- ◆ Additional activities may be added during the school year. The After School Activities Coordinator will notify students about the information of a new club or activity.
- ◆ Activities are NOT held on early dismissal days, days with weather closings, or days when school is not in session. *There will also be no activities scheduled on November 21st and 22nd, and Monday through Thursday during the week of December 19th to allow after school staff time for professional development.*
- ◆ Our goals, rules and expectations for students remain the same as during the school day. Students must be at the scheduled activity by 2:45 pm, or they will not be permitted to attend the activity. Students may not leave the building between the end of the school day and the beginning of the after school activity. Attendance is taken and sent to the after school coordinator. Not following the rules may result in the loss of afterschool privileges.

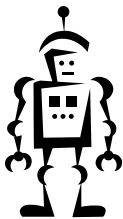


Family Support Services: SISTERS/HERMANAS— Course #318486

Data Release Consent Form for After School Programs

Dear Parent or Guardian:

Your child's after school program is part of the *Excel Beyond the Bell* initiative, a program run by the Montgomery County Collaboration Council with support from Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS). MCPS is collecting information that helps evaluate these programs. This report will be shared with our elected officials, out-of-school time program providers, and funders.

MCPS will use data from your child's school record for this evaluation. MCPS will analyze these data and produce a report that describes the student population served by out-of-school time programs and the impact made on school performance. All information will be reported in summary tables, with **NO** individual students identified. At no time will MCPS or the Montgomery County Collaboration Council share any of your child's personal information with the after school program or any other entity..

With the assistance of the Collaboration Council, your child's after school program will provide MCPS with your child's MCPS Student Identification Number (6 digits), and complete name.

MCPS will then access the following confidential information about your child to evaluate the programs:

- ◆ Confirmed Student ID
- ◆ Demographic information: age, grade in school, race/ethnicity
- ◆ Participation in Free and Reduced-price Meals System (FARMS), special education or English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) services
- ◆ Attendance in school
- ◆ Marking period grades (report cards)
- ◆ Eligibility for MCPS extracurricular activities

Your permission is strictly voluntary and has no impact on your child's participation in this after school program. You may decline to participate and have the right to withdraw your permission at any time.
