- 4) How can I **help my child at home** in terms of your class?
- 5) What are my child's **strengths** in your class?
- 6) In what **areas can my child improve**?
- 7) What **skills** have been introduced that my child will need to demonstrate again later this year or in a future school year?
- 8) How can my child earn an **A next quarter? a B? a C?**
