

Overview of Program

Throughout the school year, the goal at Roberto Clemente Middle School has been for students to be reading a book at all times. Students read many books during the school year and are in the habit of reading on a regular basis. In keeping with this practice, it is expected that students will continue reading books throughout the summer and will be accountable for that reading when they return to school in the fall.

The English/Language Arts department has designed a process for students to follow in order to prepare themselves for the coming academic school year. Included in this brochure is a recommended reading list and a list of recommended authors from which students may select their summer reading. It is suggested that students and parents review this list and make selections that will be both enjoyable and challenging.

Process for Reading

Please follow these directions for each reading:

- Students will select a book which has not been previously read and meets with parent approval.
- On a 5"x8" note card, typed paper, or loose leaf paper write the Title and Author
Main Characters with a short description
- Write a summary of the book which tells the conflict of the story, the main events, and explains how the conflict was solved.
- Upon returning to school in August, students will turn their work in to their English teacher. They will also complete a graded assignment related to the books they have read.

Sixth Grade Expectations

- Reg. Read at least one book from the author or title list.
Read one additional book of choice.
- GT Read at least two books from the author or title list.
Read one additional book of choice.
