Kindergarten

Backpack (large enough to hold a 9 X 11 inch folder), large glue sticks

Grade One

Backpack (large enough to hold a 9 X 11 inch folder), boxes of 16 crayons, glue sticks, #2 pencils, pencil box, blunt-tip scissors

Grade Two

Backpack (large enough to hold a 9 X 11 inch folder), Flexible plastic 3-ring binder, loose-leaf notebook paper, glue sticks, #2 pencils, plastic pencil box, pocket folders (red, yellow, blue, green, your choice of color), blunt-tip scissors

Grade Three

Backpack (large enough to hold a 9 X 11 inch folder), Flexible plastic 3-ring binder, loose-leaf notebook paper, dividers, #2 pencils, pocket folders (red, yellow, blue, green, purple, your choice of color), glue sticks, box of crayons, blunt-tip scissors, small school box

Grade Four

Backpack (large enough to hold a 9 X 11 inch folder), spiral notebook, #2 pencils, loose-leaf notebook paper, dividers, glue sticks, box of crayons, pocket folders

Grade Five

Backpack (large enough to hold a 9 X 11 inch folder), three-ring binder, loose-leaf notebook paper, box of 24 crayons, glue sticks, # 2 pencils, black pens, red pen, pocket folders, pencil box (labeled with name)

Items to consider for donation at all grade levels

These items are not required, but will be greatly appreciated: Liquid soup, hand sanitizers, disinfectant wipes, paper towels, facial tissue, gallon and quart-sized plastic zip-lock bags, Expo dry erase markers, pack of post-it notes, earphones with mini-plugs
