Course Description:

*Intervention classes are designed for students who have not been successful with the MCPS curriculum and/or are at risk of not meeting proficiency on the MSA.

* Lights, Camera, Literacy (introduction) class teaches 6th and 7th grade students to transfer their skills as viewers of film to skills on the written page. Students will work collaboratively to create their own short films that illustrate different aspects of filmmaking.

* Focus on Algebra emphasizes concepts and skills necessary for success in Algebra I. Preview of content from the Algebra I curriculum includes variations, quadratics, and monomials/binomials. Open to any student who is enrolled or being considered for enrollment in middle school Algebra I for fall 2009.
