Due to the extensive course load, all accepted Cosmetology students will develop a 4-year plan to meet the MSDE high school graduation requirements. This plan must include 3 years of Cosmetology, 4 years of Math & English, 3 years of Science & Social Studies, 1 year of Fine Arts & Technology Education and ½ year of Physical Education & Health. This plan may include classes completed during High School Plus or Summer School. Cosmetology also requires the completion of 1500 hours of training and taking the Maryland State Board of Cosmetology Licensing exam.

As per the MCPS Attendance Policy, all students who miss 5 or more unexcused days will be subject to the possibility of failure and removal from the CTE program.
