Your **SCHOOL COUNSELOR** has much to offer. He/she will be your:

- Advisor for researching and investigating post-secondary education.
- Source of knowledge about potential schools that “work for you.”
- Supporter and advocate by writing the letter of recommendation and completing the secondary school report.

Your **SCHOOL REGISTRAR** will help you:

- Manage the mechanics of the application process.
- Provide the official transcripts.
- Manage transcript and portage fees.
- Maintain deadlines.
