Position Duties: The Department of Natural Resources, Maryland Park Service, is currently accepting applications for a Naturalist at Seneca Creek State Park in Montgomery County. **This position is required to work weekends and holidays.** Employees will be required to work outdoors in a variety of weather conditions. Duties include developing, scheduling and presenting environmental education and recreational programs for the public, coordinating summer Junior Ranger programs for youth, guiding weekend pontoon boat tours, creating weekly advertisements and press releases for park programs and assisting with the Seneca Creek Park Quest program. Fluency in a 2nd language is a plus! Training and park issued uniforms will be provided.
