

# *LIFT Summer Bridge Program!*

LIFT's Summer Bridge program allows students entering college in the fall to prepare for their transition while living on campus at the University of Maryland, College Park!

Students will:

- Enroll in a University of Maryland course - credit may transfer to the college/university the student plans to attend  
**Students will choose one of the following three courses:**  
Sociology 105 (Introduction to Contemporary Social Problems),  
Philosophy 170(Introduction to Logic)  
Art 100 (Introduction to two-dimensional design)
- Take an Introduction to the University course
- Learn peer leadership/mentoring skills by mentoring younger students in the summer pre-college programs on campus and by taking a Leadership Seminar
- Live on campus at the University of Maryland, College Park

The program will run June 21 - July 31, 2009. Students will live on campus and attend class during the week, and will go home on weekends. Cost is \$4,500 (includes tuition, room and board).

Priority registration deadline is May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2009. Eligible students are graduating high school in May and have been accepted to a college/university for Fall 2009. (Students do not need to plan on attending University of Maryland to be eligible)
