Summer Pre-Biomanufacturing Program

For students preparing to enter the Biomanufacturing Certificate or Biotechnology A.A.S. Programs in Fall 2009.

All students take *BT101 Introduction to Biotechnology (2 credits)* and either *CH 100A Introductory College Chemistry (3 credits)* or *BI 107 Principles of Biology (4 credits)*

In order to qualify students must:

- Complete application packet by June 1, 2009
- Have completed high school biology or chemistry with a grade of B or better
- Take the College's Assessment tests or have the SAT scores necessary to enroll in CH 100A or BI 107
- Participate in a baseline skills assessment
- Agree to enroll in either the Biomanufacturing Certificate Program or the Biotechnology A.A.S degree program in Fall 2009. Partial scholarships are available for the Fall.
