# MONTGOMERY COLLEGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES ACADEMIC SPECIALTY SCHOLARSHIP

The **Board of Trustees (BOT) Academic Specialty Scholarship** is for talented Montgomery County high school graduates who plan to enroll at **any Montgomery College campus in the fall of 2007**. This is a **one-year** (two semesters - fall 2007 and spring 2008) scholarship that covers the full-time cost of tuition and fees (up to 15 credit hours at the county resident tuition rate). This award does **not** include the cost of books, supplies, or personal expenses. The award is based on academic achievement and potential, not financial need. In addition, pending sufficient funding, recipients of fall 2007 BOT Academic Specialty scholarships may be eligible for an extension of their scholarship for a second year of study at Montgomery College, if the recipient maintains a cumulative Montgomery College GPA of 3.4 or higher.

The **BOT Academic Specialty Scholarship** is a competitive program awarding scholarships to high school graduates entering any of the College's degree programs. (Please consult the *Montgomery College Catalog* for a description of each degree program.) A committee of staff and faculty will review the applications and select the recipients. Students will be considered for an award based on their demonstration of academic potential and their essays.

**The deadline to apply for a fall 2007 BOT Specialty Scholarship is April 30, 2007.** Students will be notified of the scholarship committee decision by **June 15, 2007**.

To be considered for a BOT scholarship, students must meet the following requirements:

- June 2007 **Montgomery County** high school graduate
- Admitted to a degree program at Montgomery College
- **Minimum 3.0 high school grade point average (weighted grade point average)**

To be considered for a BOT scholarship, students must submit the following materials:

- Official high school transcript, including first semester senior year grades
- BOT Specialty Scholarship Application form
- Recommendation from a high school teacher, counselor, or principal

NOTES:

- Students who apply for the Montgomery Scholars Honors Program for fall 2007 do not need to complete a BOT Specialty Scholarship application. Montgomery Scholars applicants who are not admitted into the Montgomery Scholars program may be considered for BOT Scholarships based upon their complete application materials submitted to the Scholars program.
- Students interested in the Biomedical Scholars Program, Macklin Business Institute, Health Sciences, or Computer Science, Engineering & Math (CSEM) program are encouraged to apply for BOT scholarships by the April 30, 2007 deadline.
- Students who plan to enroll at Montgomery College for only one semester (fall 2007) may apply for the BOT scholarship; however, priority consideration for BOT scholarships will be given to students who intend to enroll at Montgomery College for one year (two semesters - fall 2007 and spring 2008).
- If a recipient's parent is an employee of Montgomery College and the student is eligible for a tuition waiver, the recipient will have his or her fees covered by the scholarship award (up to 15 credits at the in-county rate).
