Eligibility:

1. Applicant must be a graduating senior during the 2011-2012 school year.
2. Applicant must submit a completed application.
3. Applicant must have a 3.0 or greater grade-point average from the time of application through the completion of the 12th grade.
4. Applicant must submit proof of community service activities in the form of a letter on official organization letterhead.
5. Applicant must submit two letters of recommendations from community representatives including, but not limited to, a supervisor, religious leader, teacher or counselor.
6. Applicant must submit scholarship application and all required documents by Saturday, March 31, 2012. Failure to follow the application guidelines or to meet this deadline may result in disqualification.
