Why is it important? Students benefit tremendously from time reading at home. BookFlix is a new interactive literacy resource that pairs a fiction and nonfiction book online. This is great for children to gain knowledge on the topics they are reading about. BookFlix can be used anywhere with remote internet access. It can help motivate and build fluency skills of early readers, reluctant readers, and English Language Learners.

Features of BookFlix:

- **Read along option** with highlighted text.
- **Educational games-** Engaging activities aimed to develop vocabulary skills and help students tell the difference between fact and fiction.
- **Author biographies** to build reader's interest in future readings.
- Editorially selected **web links** to encourage children to continue learning about topics of interest.
