- 4) What types of assignments is my child expected to do independently?
- 5) How can I help my child at home in terms of your class?
- 6) What are my child's strengths in your class?
- 7) In what areas can my child improve?
- 8) What skills have been introduced that my child will need to demonstrate again later this year or in a future school year?
- 9) How can my child earn an A next quarter? a B? a C?
