Magruder Homecoming Dance Tickets *If I Could Change the World*

Magruder Homecoming Dance Tickets are now on sale thru the online store and by mail. The dance will be held on Saturday, October 20th, from 8:00 to 11:00 p.m. in the MHS gymnasium. All Magruder students are eligible to attend. However, **we are limited to selling only 1500 tickets** due to the size of the dance venue, the gym. What this means is, if you want to be sure that you get your ticket(s), **don't wait to order.**

Mail orders must be received by October 5. Online sales end October 15th. Single tickets are \$15 and the cost for a pair is \$30. In the unlikely event that not all 1500 tickets are sold by October 15th, then the remaining tickets will be sold at school October 17th-19th for \$20 per ticket. (But don't count on tickets being

available at that time)
