

Montgomery Village Middle School Extended Year Program 2009

Math 6 Support emphasizes statistics and data, fractions, decimals, ratios, and percents, and measurement. The program reviews content from elementary math curriculum and previews some indicators from the Math 6 curriculum.

Math 7 Support emphasizes content from the first two units of Math 7, including displaying and interpreting data, exponents, integers, expressions, equations and inequalities. The program reviews content from previous math curricula and previews some indicators from the Math 7 curriculum.

Focus on Algebra emphasizes concepts and skills necessary for success in Algebra I. The program reviews content on integers, rational numbers, expressions, and equations. Preview of content from the Algebra I curriculum includes variations, quadratics, and monomials/binomials.

Reading 6, 7, and 8: Each course, using the appropriate grade level materials, will focus on the following four reading strategies: *context clues, main idea, inference, and summarization*. The classes will also be using Gourmet Curriculum Main Dishes and Dessert activities appropriate for grade levels, as well as Reader's Theater, Jamestown Fluency, Scholastic Magazine, Daily Oral Language, activators, writing component, books on tape, and summer reading projects for the start of the next school year.

"Lights, Camera, Literacy!" teaches students to transfer their skills as viewers of film to skills on the written page. Students will learn to "read" film at the literary, dramatic and cinematic levels and work collaboratively to create their own short films that illustrate different aspects of filmmaking.

The focus is on increasing literacy in both written and visual texts, improving collaboration skills, building confidence and motivation, and providing opportunities for higher level thinking via the strategies used in the competitive worlds of chess and spelling competitions.
