

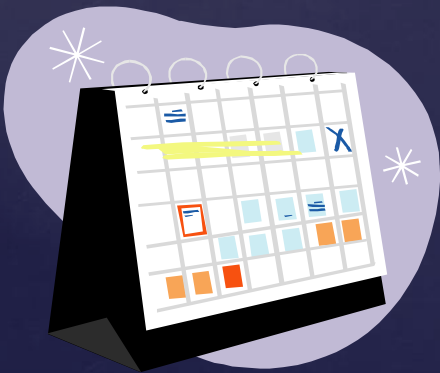

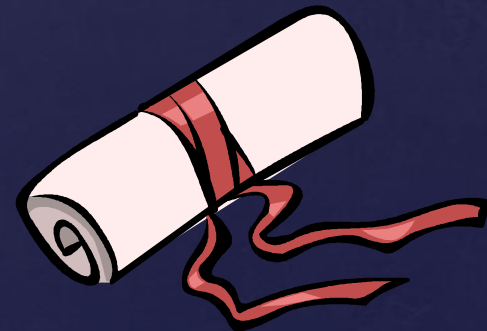

# Maryland State Requirements for Graduation



- 4 credits (years) of English
- 3 credits of Science (1 physical sci. and 1 biology)
- 4 credits of Math (1 algebra and 1 geometry)
- 3 credits of Social Studies (USH, NSL, MWH)
- 1 credit of Fine Art
- 1 credit of Physical Education
- 1 credit of Technology
- .5 credit of Health
- Program Completion Requirement:
  - 2 credits of foreign language
  - 2 credits of advanced technology
  - 4 credits of a career development program
- 2.5 credits of Electives (this is easily completed by all Northwood students)

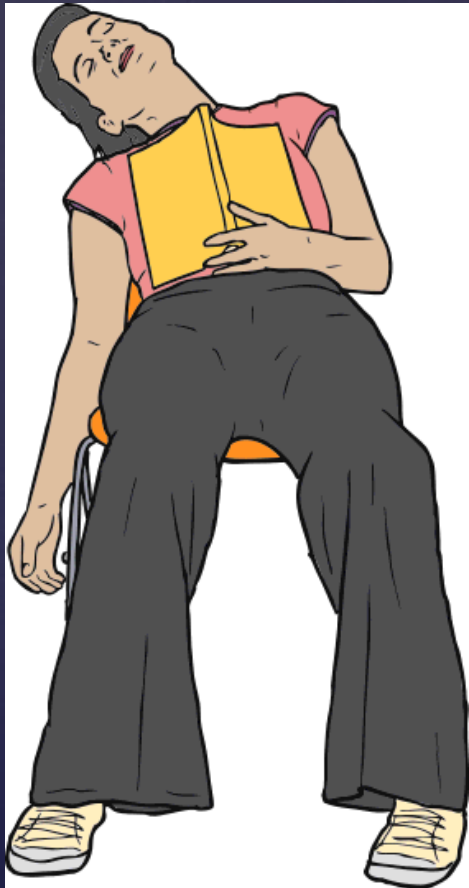

# Abbreviated Schedules

# Abbreviated Schedules (cont.)

- Transcripts sent to colleges represent seniors' accomplishments and efforts throughout high school.
- 9<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> grade courses and grades are listed on the transcript. All courses in which a senior applicant is enrolled are also listed on the transcript.
- This is not the time to demonstrate to college admission officers that you are tired of school.
- This is the last year that your education is free!

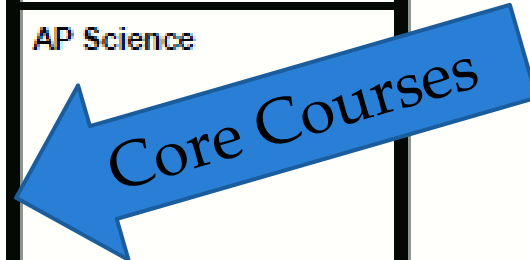
- Your registration card includes your course recommendations for **next year**.
