- Has very, very good office hours.

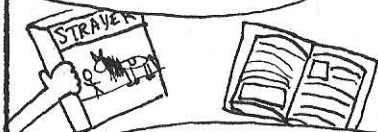

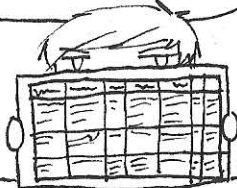

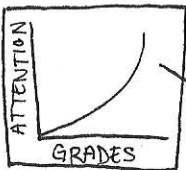


Failure to read results

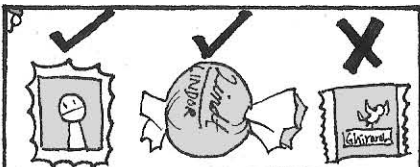
