

# MONEY FOR NOTHIN'

OTES participates in programs offered by grocery stores and other retail businesses to earn money for the school based on purchases made. The percentages of money earned from purchases varies with the program and retailer but, on average, range from .5% to 5%. Designate Oakland Terrace ES, do your normal shopping and earn money for OTES at the same time. It's almost like "money for nothing". Get your friends, neighbors, family members and alumni to sign-up and participate.

## **BOX TOPS FOR EDUCATION**

The "Box Tops for Education" and "Labels for Education" found on many food products can be clipped to raise funds for the school. On average, the box tops are valued at 10 cents each. Please seal the box tops in plastic bags and leave them in the box marked "Box Tops for Education" outside of the school office.



## **CHEVY CHASE SUPERMARKET & SNIDER'S MARKET**

These markets donate 1% of all purchases in their stores to OTES. Deposit your receipts in the "Money for Nothin'" box outside the school office. The programs run continuously through the calendar year.

## **GIANT**

Giant donates a percentage of all purchases when using the Giant Bonus card in their stores. Designate OTES **#00861** at [www.giantfood.com/aplus](http://www.giantfood.com/aplus) or 1-877-366-2668. Yearly registration is required and the program runs from October-April.

## **SAFEWAY**

Safeway donates up to 3% of purchases when using the Safeway Club Card in the store. Designate OTES **#6666867** at [www.escrip.com](http://www.escrip.com) or at the store. Yearly registration is required and the program runs from October-May.

## **TARGET**

Donations total 1% of your purchases at Target and Target.com when using your Target credit card and 1/2% of Target Visa Credit Card purchases when used at places other than Target.
