

# **Rachel Carson Elementary School**

## **Grade Level Supply Lists 2009-2010**

*It is recommended that students bring the following individual organizational tools and personal supplies to school. Grade levels have also included requests for donations (see back page). These items are always greatly appreciated.*

**Kindergarten:** Backpack (large enough to hold a 9 x 11 inch folder – **no wheels**), one box of 24 crayons, glue sticks, 1 hardcover composition book, 2 yellow highlighters, 2 black fine line felt tip markers, 1 pair child scissors, box of thick-tip markers.

**Grade One:** Backpack (large enough to hold a 9 x 11 inch folder), one box of 48 crayons, glue sticks, #2 pencils, 1 colored pencils, 1 pencil box, two 3 pronged folders, pencil box, highlighter, eraser tops for #2 pencils, 1 pair child scissors, 2 Expo markers.

**Grade Two:** Backpack (large enough to hold a 9 x 11 inch folder), personal binders (clear view), eraser tops for #2 pencils, personal composition book, one box of 24 + crayons, large sized glue sticks, #2 pencils, 4 pocket folders (solid colors only), 1 pencil box/pencil pouch, scissors.

**Grade Three:** Backpack (large enough to hold a 9 x 11 inch folder), personal binder, notebook dividers, glue sticks, two-dozen #2 pencils (non-mechanical), 4 pocket folders (solid colors only), 2 personal composition book, 1 pencil pouch for binder, scissors, 2 spiral notebooks (solid colors only), 1 box of 12 colored pencils, 12" ruler, 1 pair of child scissors.

**Grade Four:** Backpack (large enough to hold a 9 x 11 inch folder), one three-ring binder (2-inch), 150 count wide-rule notebook paper, subject dividers (5), one box of 12 colored pencils, 3 spiral notebooks (red cover, blue cover and green cover), sharpened #2 pencils (non-mechanical), 1 pencil pouch with holes for binder, 3 highlighters, 1 12" ruler, 2 oblong erasers, fine tip markers, large sized glue sticks.

**Grade Five:** Backpack (large enough to hold a 9 x 11 inch folder), notebook subject dividers, one box of 24 + crayons, glue sticks, #2 pencils, (non-mechanical), red pens, 6 different colored pocket folders, 1 pencil pouch, 6 different colored single subject spiral notebooks, eraser tops for pencils, scissors, colored pencils.

***Kindergarten:*** gallon and quart-sized plastic zip-lock bags, hand sanitizers, liquid hand soap, slightly used tennis balls, Dixie cups 3 oz. and 5 oz., paper plates, facial tissue, brown paper lunch bags, disinfectant wipes

***Grade 1:*** box of assorted plastic forks, spoons and knives, gallon and sandwich-sized plastic zip-lock bags, hand sanitizers, liquid hand soap, facial tissue, disinfectant wipes, snack and celebration money (\$10)

***Grade 2:*** stickers, gallon and sandwich-sized plastic zip-lock bags, hand sanitizers, liquid hand soap, facial tissue, disinfectant wipes, scissors

***Grade 3:*** baby wipes, box of assorted plastic forks, spoons and knives, brown paper grocery bags, gallon and sandwich-sized plastic zip-lock bags, hand sanitizers, liquid hand soap, facial tissue, disinfectant wipes, paper plates, stickers, slightly used tennis balls

***Grade 4:*** boxes of facial tissues, gallon and sandwich-sized plastic zip-lock bags, hand sanitizers, disinfectant wipes, 5" pointed tip stainless-steel scissors

***Grade 5:*** gallon and sandwich-sized plastic zip-lock bags, hand sanitizers, liquid hand soap, facial tissue, disinfectant wipes
