Expectations of members

- 1) Bring all ski/snowboard equipment to Mr. Rea before 7:25 AM.
- 2) Equipment will be stored in room 2009 on the second floor.
- 3) If you can not attend on Friday, please notify Mr. Rea in advance.
- 4) Inform your 7th period teacher that you are a member of the Ski/Snowboard club.
Get missed work or homework assignments in advance.
- 5) Report to your period 7 class and respectfully ask to be dismissed at approximately 1:50.
- 6) Quietly leave class, collect equipment and report to bus located at the front of building.
- 7) Buses will leave the RHS parking lot at 2:10. Be prompt. We will not wait for you.
- 8) At the mountain, be respectful and courteous. Ski within your limits.
Buddy up. Use lessons.
- 9) If you are injured, parents will be asked to come and get you & staff from the mountain.
- 10) On the return trip, report to the bus at the correct time. We pay the bus company by the hour. Your tardiness may be costly.
- 11) Remind parents to be prompt when picking you up.
On most trips we will be leaving the ski slopes at 10:00. Our return to RHS parking lot should be approximately 11:30. On the 2 trips to Ski Roundtop we will be returning about 30 minutes later.
- 12) MCPS and RHS rules and policies apply to you at all times while on trip.
- 13) We Ski/snowboard in any weather condition. If MCPS is closed we will still attend our trip.
- 14) The RHS Ski Club is sponsored by the Montgomery County Recreation Teen Club.
As a member you are qualified to participate in any Montgomery County recreation trips or clubs.
