## ONE LUNCH PROGRAM

#### Time:

- 55 minutes: 11:35 am to 12:30 pm closed lunch
- Edison Center and Special Education students will attend AM programs

#### Food Services Access Sites:

- 7 food sites:
  - 4 in Cafeteria (including 8 microwaves for student use in seating area in Cafeteria) - only cash site
  - 2 hot/cold in indoor concession stand
  - 1 snack/cold site in Main Entrance area under mounted TV
- Vending Machines will remain available during lunch period only

#### Food Purchases:

- Springbrook ID cards will have a barcode that will be used both in the Media Center and for food purchasing
  - SNAP payment system equipment for all 7 food access sites that allows swiping of ID cards rather than punching in pin numbers (although you can still punch in pin numbers if necessary-pin numbers are the same for a student for entire high school enrollment)
  - ID cards will be provided first day of school and reissued each school year as part of student portrait package
- Cafeteria account prepayment for your student/s should be made as soon as possible for timely credit to access the first day of school. Please refer to *2011-12 Cafeteria News and Secondary School Meals Information* sheet in this summer information packet for further detailed information.

#### Eating Areas:

- First Floor main hallways only (E/F/G hallways off limits) from Cafeteria to end of D hallway; tables strategically placed for student use. 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> floor hallways off limits for general eating areas.
- Cafeteria Courtyard (weather permitting)
- Interior Courtyard – seniors only (weather permitting)

#### Classroom Use:

- Department/teacher specific

#### Computer Labs:

- Computer labs will be open and available during lunch period

#### Media Center:

- Open for quiet study, schoolwork and/or focused activities such as chess, checkers, etc.

#### Counseling Services:

- Counseling services will be available the entire 55 minute period

#### Electronic Equipment Usage:

- Students will be allowed to use cell phones, iPods (w/earplugs only), etc. during lunch period.
