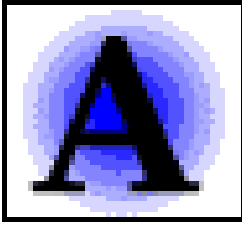
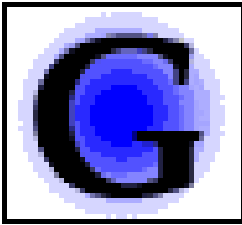


AGOPP Research Model



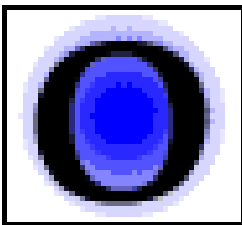
Ask Questions

- Identify your research problem or question
- Read about the issue
- Analyze the problem and develop questions



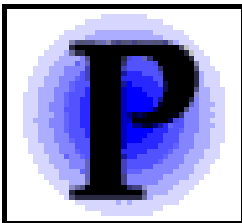
Gather Information

- Gather keywords based on questions
- Choose the best source of information (books, internet, periodicals, etc.)
- Search for the information
- Record notes and bibliographic information



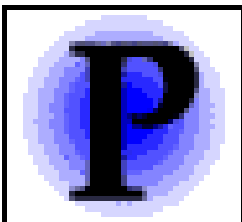
Organize Information

- Summarize your findings
- Draw conclusions and inferences
- Use a graphical organizer or note card "slugs" to arrange the information



Prepare Information

- Decide the best medium(s) to use to communicate the information (May be part of the assignment)
- Prepare a first draft of a written paper or speech or prepare a script and/or storyboard
- Prepare a Works Cited page



Present Information

- Revise your first draft (use peer reviewers or a teacher to help you). Revise again if necessary
 - Prepare your final product
 - Present the product to your audience
 - Evaluate your process and product
